Restricted/Prohibited Substances: Lead, Mercury, Cadmium, Hexavalent Chromium, Polybrominated Biphenyls (PBB), Polybrominated Diphenyl Ethers (PBDE), Deca-BDE and BPA.

In an effort to become compliant with legislation in Europe and China, Zeus Industrial Products, Inc. has reviewed the content of materials purchased from our vendor supply base. This includes resin, pigments, wire, processing aides, and packaging. Below is a listing of the resins that were reviewed, in their natural state, with no fillers or pigments. None of these resins were found to contain any of the substances above the limits set by the particular legislation as it is currently written.

Some pigments used to manufacture tubing have been found to contain some of these restricted/banned substances. Zeus Industrial Products, Inc. does have a selection of pigments that have been certified as heavy metal free that may be used in combination with the resins listed above to replace product that would be considered not compliant under either directive.

Zeus Industrial Products, Inc. does not use any of these substances as intentional ingredients in the manufacture of natural tubing made from the resins listed above. While we do not routinely analyze the final products for the substances, we do not expect any to be present.
